**Terms and Conditions 2021/22**

1. To be eligible, applicants must meet all of the following conditions.

- Hold an offer for a place on a full time degree course listed in the 'Eligibility' section of the application form
- Hold an offer for a place on the 7-week online pre-sessional English (PSE) course starting in Summer 2022
- Be assessed as Overseas student for fee purposes
- New entrants only, current students at the University of Westminster are not eligible to apply

2. The Pre-Sessional English Scholarship is awarded towards the cost of the 7-week Online Pre-Sessional English course tuition fee only. Students who need a 13-week or 10-week Online Pre-sessional English courses are not eligible. Awardees are solely responsible for tuition fee payments for the degree course studies from September 2022.

3. The scholarship will be paid directly to the University's Finance Offices on behalf of the student by the Scholarships office toward tuition fees for the 7-week Online Pre-sessional English programme only.

4. Students will still need to pay the £4,000 deposit to secure a place at the University. The Scholarship will only be confirmed when the deposit payment has been made.

5. All decisions are made by the scholarship panel and are final. Any applications submitted after the published deadline will not be considered. We will inform the awards within 5 working days after the applications. Please note we are unable to provide individual feedback.

6. You can only be awarded one scholarship. Students in receipt of this scholarship will not be considered for another type of international scholarships for September 2022 intake.

7. Scholarships cannot be deferred to another academic year or transferred to another course.

8. Recipients of this award are expected to participate in University promotional activities, attendance at University events and the annual scholarship reception.
