#### **University of Westminster International Early Birds Scholarships**

#### Terms and Conditions 2023/24

1. To be eligible, applicants must meet all of the following conditions.

- Has a course offer for a place on a full time undergraduate or postgraduate taught programme for the 2023/24 academic year
- Be registered as a full-time student and be classified as oversea for fee purpose
- Join your academic course at the given start date and before the enrolment deadline
- **Priority is given to new entrants** at the University as current or former students at the University of Westminster may be entitled to a separate alumni discount.

2. The scholarship of £1,000 is awarded towards tuition fees for **one year only**, **in the first academic year of study**. Students must pay any additional costs incurred for subsequent years of study or extensions to their standard course duration.

3. The scholarship will be paid directly to the University's Finance Offices on behalf of the student by the Scholarships office toward tuition fees **in November of your first academic year**.

4. All decisions are made by the scholarship panel and are final. Any applications submitted after the published deadline will not be considered. We will inform the awards within 4 weeks after the deadline. Please note we are unable to provide individual feedback on applications.

5. You can only be awarded one scholarship. Students applying for other University of Westminster Awards will only be considered for one.

6. Scholarships cannot be deferred to another academic year. If you decide to defer your studies to the next academic year, you should apply again for our scholarships in the following year once you have an offer for the new academic year. There is no guarantee that we will offer the same scholarships each year, or that you will be offered a scholarship again after reapplying. Exceptions may be considered for students deferring from September to January start courses within the same academic year. You should request consent from the Scholarships team.

7. If an awardee decides to change programmes, the student will be entitled to keep the scholarship provided that the new course and mode of study meets the eligibility criteria. All changes must be approved by the Scholarships Office beforehand.

8. The following categories of students are not eligible:

a. Postgraduate Diploma (including Legal Practice Postgraduate Diploma)

- b. Professional courses (eg RIBA pt III, ACCA, CIMA, CiLEX)
- c. Research level courses (eg MPhil/PhD)
- d. Part time courses

9. Recipients of this award are expected to act in an ambassadorial capacity, to provide student profiles or testimonials, and to attend University's promotion or recruitment activities as required to include the annual scholarship reception.
