INFORMATION

The scholarship provides a one off £1000 or £2000 tuition fee award and is open to Overseas fee-paying students. Selection is based on academic merit and personal statement.

ELIGIBILITY

Students must fulfil all criteria below: You must

- be an overseas fee-paying student and hold an offer for a full-time Undergraduate or Postgraduate Taught (PGT) degree course at the University of Westminster starting in September 2022
- be studying full-time or be a resident in mainland China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, South Korea and Japan
- demonstrate excellent academic performance or have impressive achievements in other areas
- confirm your place by paying the £4,000 deposit by 30th June 2022
- submit an application for this scholarship by 30th June 2022

Terms and Conditions 2022/23

- 1. To be eligible, applicants must meet all of the following conditions.
- Course offer for a place on a full time undergraduate or postgraduate taught programme for the 2022/23 academic year
- Assessed as Overseas student for fee purposes
- New entrants only, current students at the University of Westminster are not eligible to apply
- 2. The scholarship of £1,000 or £2000 is awarded for the first academic year of study only towards tuition fees. Students must pay the full cost of tuition in subsequent years of study.
- 3. The scholarship will be paid directly to the University's Finance Offices on behalf of the student by the Scholarships office toward tuition fees in November 2022.
- 4. All decisions are made by the scholarship panel and are final. Any applications submitted after the published deadline will not be considered. We will inform the awards within 4 weeks after the deadline. Please note we are unable to provide individual feedback.
- 5. You can only be awarded one scholarship. For graduates of the University of Westminster we offer a separate alumni discount which can be combined with an International Early Birds scholarship.
- 6. Scholarships cannot be deferred to another academic year.
- 7. If an awardee decides to change programmes, the student will be entitled to keep the scholarship provided that the new course and mode of study meets the eligibility criteria. All changes must be approved by the Scholarships Office beforehand.
- 8. The following categories of students are not eligible:
- a. Postgraduate Diploma
- b. Professional courses (eg RIBA pt III, ACCA, CIMA, CiLEX)
- c. Conversion courses (eg Graduate Diploma in Law)
- d. Integrated Masters/MPhil/PhD student
- e. Part time students
- 9. Recipients of this award are expected to participate in University promotional activities, attendance at University events and the annual scholarship reception.
